All:

I have received replies back from both prosecutor and defense counsel indicating that they have no objection to demolition of the King Road house. I have attached copies of both communications for you. As a result, it is our plan to proceed with the required remediation inside the house followed by demolition. I am discussing the schedule for this with the remediation company and will give you notice prior to either event occurring. I don't want you to be surprised in the event there is media attention.

Both Dean Eckles and I have heard from some of you regarding personal items that you would like to recover from the house if possible. As I said in my initial letter, the university intends to gather up what we can and make it available to you at another location. I am working with the remediation company and would like to offer you my assistance by walking through the house to look for items you have described. This will occur prior to remediation beginning. Either Dean Eckles or I can have further discussions on this with any of you who wish to make more detailed descriptions. As law enforcement has already removed many items from the residence, I can make no promises as to what I will find, but I will do my best to recover items you've identified.

In order to keep this process moving ahead please call or send the information regarding items you would like us to try to retrieve by April 20. You can provide that information either to me or Dean Eckles. Once I have completed the walk through, someone from the University will reach back out to you individually to let you know what we found and what we think can be retrieved.

Thank you for your patience as we navigate this difficult circumstance. Each of you and your families remain in my thoughts and prayers. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.
